PARISH AND CRUSADER LISTS

It is a chore to keep the parish census up to date. Also, *The Crusader* will be mailed in the coming weeks. We try to send adult children living at home their own Crusader if they would like their own copy.

For parish membership records and separately *The Crusader* mail list, please do the following:

- Register with the parish office through the switchboard if you are new to the parish or have not previously registered.
- Let the switchboard know if you move (***including*** if you move to another parish).
- Let the switchboard know if you are receiving *The Crusader* for individuals that do not desire or benefit from their own copy or who live elsewhere.
- If you know of individuals that are not getting *The Crusader* but they would appreciate getting their own copy, let us know.
- Remind adult children out of high school they must register as parishioners whether living at home or elsewhere.
- Let the switchboard know if children (typically adults) have moved away from the parish.
- Be sure you have an Assumption Chapel information form on file if you are having children baptized. This a requirement if any in the family live locally and are receiving any of the sacraments.
- Be sure you file a new parish information form when you get married (or otherwise let the parish know if you are moving away upon getting married). This is a required step when receiving the sacrament of matrimony.

Everyone's effort to keep our records accurate is appreciated.
